NatGold Digital Ltd. (“we,” “us,” “our,” or “NatGold”) offers a token that allows you to invest in independently verified in-ground gold deposits through digital mining. We want you to be familiar with how we collect, use, and disclose personal information. This Privacy Policy describes how we handle personal information that we collect through our websites, social media pages, online communications, and any other sites or services that link to this Privacy Policy (collectively, the “Services”).

PERSONAL INFORMATION WE COLLECT

Here’s how we collect personal information in providing our Services.

DATA CATEGORIES	EXAMPLES
Identifiers and Contact Information	First and last name, date of birth, email address, telephone number, and postal address.
Employment Information	Your role and your organization’s name.
Wallet and Transaction Information	Wallet identifiers, details about your purchases of NatGold tokens, blockchain transaction data related to NatGold token transfers, and other publicly available blockchain ledger information.
Social Media Information	Content you may create or share with us during our relationship, including your social media account ID and profile picture and any posts on our social media pages and comment sections.
Preferences	Language, interests, and other feedback/preferences that you might express during your use of our Services.
Marketing Data	Choices regarding our newsletters, surveys, and other marketing displayed or provided to you, and preferred methods of receiving such promotional communication.
Relationship Information	Actions you have taken on the Services, details of your communications with us, and details of your claims, complaints, and queries in general.

Personal information collected automatically through your use of our Services	
DATA CATEGORIES	EXAMPLES
Online Activity Data	Pages or screens you viewed, how long you spent on a page or screen, navigation paths between pages or screens, information about your activity on a page or screen, access times, and duration of access, and whether you have opened our marketing emails or clicked links within them.

Device Information	Your device's operating system type and version, manufacturer and model, screen resolution, RAM and disk size, CPU usage, device type (e.g., phone, tablet), IP address, language settings, mobile device carrier, radio/network information (e.g., WiFi, LTE, 3G), advertising ID, and general location information.
We use the following tools for automatic data collection	
Cookies	<p>Cookies are pieces of information stored directly on the device that you are using and allow us to collect information such as browser type, time spent on the Services, pages visited, language preferences, and other traffic data. We and our service providers may use the information for security purposes, to facilitate navigation, display information more effectively, conduct analytics, and personalize your experience.</p> <p>We do not currently respond to browser do-not-track signals. Local Storage Technologies	These technologies provide cookie-equivalent functionality but can store larger amounts of data, including on your device outside of your browser in connection with specific applications.
Pixel Tags	Also known as web beacons and clear GIFs, pixel tags may be used to, among other things, track the actions of users of the Services (including email recipients), measure the success of our marketing campaigns, and compile statistics about usage of the Services and response rates.
Google Analytics	We use Google Analytics, which uses cookies and similar technologies to collect and analyze information about use of the Services and report on activities and trends. This service may also collect information regarding the use of other websites, apps and online resources. Other Third Parties	We may collect information from sources such as publicly available databases, marketing partners, third-party providers, and data brokers.

We need to collect personal information to provide the requested Services to you. If you do not provide the information requested, we may not be able to provide the Services. If you disclose any Personal Information relating to other people to us or to our service providers in connection with the Services, you

HOW WE USE PERSONAL INFORMATION

PURPOSES	EXAMPLES
Administering the Services	To manage our contractual relationship with you, we may use your personal information to provide the Services to you, including completing your transactions, verifying your information, responding to your inquiries, fulfilling your requests, and sending you administrative information such as agreements to provide the Services and changes to our terms, conditions, and policies.
Operations and General Business	To manage our contractual relationship with you and to fulfil our legitimate business interests, we may use your personal information when we conduct our operations (such as troubleshooting, diagnostic testing, performance analyses of our systems and Services, testing of new system features to evaluate their impact, system and log maintenance, technical support, system debugging, and hosting data) and to facilitate mergers, acquisitions, and other reorganizations and restructurings of our business (including prospective transactions).
Marketing and Promotions	To fulfil our legitimate business interests, we may use your personal information to send you our newsletters, publications, updates, and invitations that we think may be of interest to you, and to allow you to participate in sweepstakes, contests, or other promotions.
Relationship Building and Engagement	To manage our contractual relationship with you and to fulfil our legitimate business interests, we may use your personal information to respond to any posts on our social media pages and to conduct other user relationship building activities.
Personalizing Our Services	To fulfil our legitimate business interests, we may use your personal information to personalize our interactions with you and to provide you with information and/or offers tailored to your interests, such as delivering content that we believe will be relevant and interesting to you.
Improving and Developing Our Services	To fulfil our legitimate business interests, we may use your personal information to conduct data analysis, to monitor and analyze use of the Services, to use data analytics to improve the efficiency of our Services, to develop new features, to enhance, improve, repair, maintain, or modify our Services, to identify usage trends, to understand which parts of our Services are most interesting to users, to determine the effectiveness of our promotional campaigns, and for other similar purposes.
Aggregation and/or Anonymization	To fulfil our legitimate business interests, we may anonymize and aggregate personal information that does not identify you or another individual and use and share such data for our own business purposes.

Security and Fraud Prevention	To manage our contractual relationship with you, to comply with our legal obligations, and to fulfil our legitimate business interests, we may use your personal information to conduct audits, to verify that our internal processes function as intended and are compliant with legal, regulatory, or contractual requirements, to monitor for and prevent fraud, and for security purposes, including maintaining system security.
Legal and Compliance	To manage our contractual relationship with you and to comply with our legal obligations, we may use your personal information to fulfill our legal and compliance-related obligations, including complying with applicable laws, complying with legal processes, responding to requests from public and government authorities, meeting national security or law enforcement requirements, complying with requirements set by industry-specific supervisory bodies, enforcing our terms and conditions and standards, protecting our operations, protecting the rights, privacy, or property of our business, responding to auditors, pursuing available legal remedies, making insurance claims, defending claims, and limiting the damages that we may sustain.

HOW WE DISCLOSE PERSONAL INFORMATION

If you would like another person (an “agent”) to make a request on your behalf as permitted by applicable law, the agent may use the submission methods noted above. As part of our verification process, we may request that the agent provide proof of their authorization by you to submit the request.

Please note that we may need to retain certain information for recordkeeping purposes and/or to complete any transactions that you began prior to requesting a change or deletion (e.g., when you make a purchase or enter a promotion, you may not be able to change or delete the personal information provided until after the completion of such purchase or promotion). Further, certain personal information may be exempt from requests pursuant to applicable data protection laws or other laws and regulations.

RETENTION PERIOD

We retain personal information for as long as needed or permitted in light of the purposes for which it was obtained as outlined in this Privacy Policy unless a longer retention period is required or permitted by applicable law. The criteria used to determine our retention periods include:

- The length of time we have an ongoing relationship with you (for example, for as long as you keep using our Services);
- Whether there is a legal obligation to which we are subject (for example, certain laws require us to keep records or communications for a certain period before we can delete them); or
- Whether retention is advisable considering our legal position (such as in regard to applicable statutes of limitations, litigation, or regulatory investigations).
